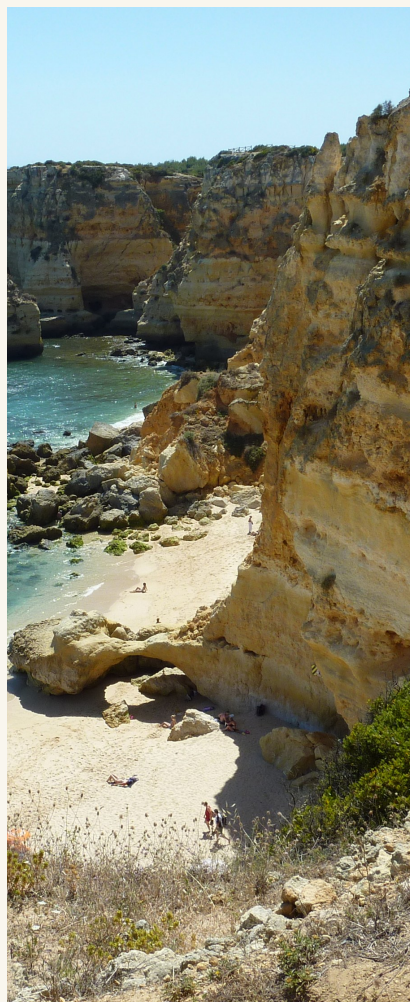

Breakfast and coordinated departures, with the option to stay longer or begin a honeymoon in Portugal.

DAY 4

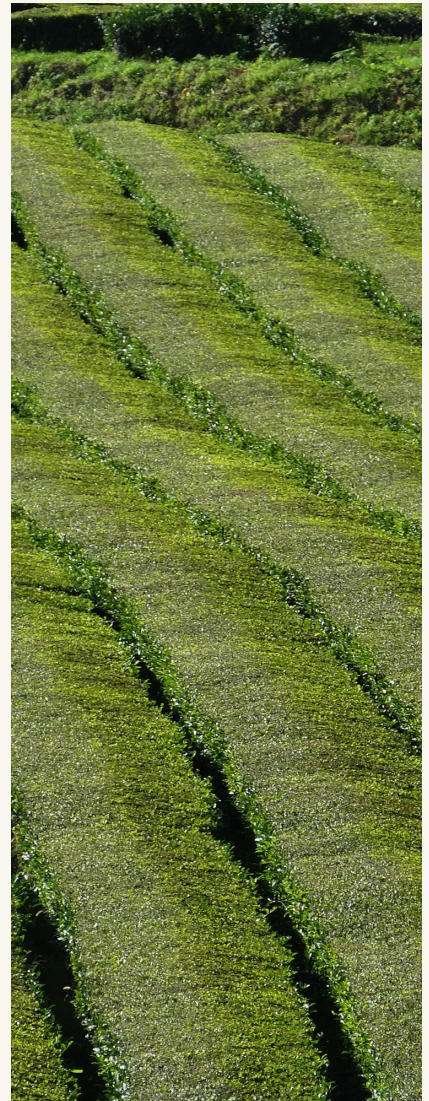
Celebrate a little longer
